POLICY

Application

This policy shall apply to the clinical services of The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness.

1. Scope of Practice

- 1.1. The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness staff and contractors will provide clinical services and supports only within their scope of practice. Personnel shall not represent themselves as competent outside of their scope of practice.
- 1.2. All clinical personnel engaged in the planning or delivery of clinical services shall practice under the supervision of appropriate licensed professionals, unless privileged by the CEO to practice in that area or perform specific functions independently.
- 1.3. The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness maintains a procedure for approving clinical privileges for competent, licensed independent practitioners.
- 1.4. Clinical privileges may only be granted by the Chief Executive Officer.
