POLICY

Application

This policy shall apply to The Right Door for Hope, Recovery and Wellness and all services operated by or under contract with it.

1.0 Refusal of Treatment

- 1.1 A recipient receiving services shall have the right to refuse treatment and services.
- 1.2 The recipient shall be informed of the consequences of refusal of treatment and services.
- 1.3 If the recipient’s refusal prevents the program from providing treatment and services, the relationship with the recipient may be terminated with written approval by the Program Supervisor.
- 1.4 Reasons for the termination will be documented in the recipient record.
